Title: Registered Public Health Nurse **Division:** Nursing– Brigham City and Tremonton area **Grade:** 21 Step 1

Summary of Duties: Under the general supervision of the Nursing Division Director, acts as a Nurse Care Manager to address the physical and behavioral health needs of low-income and uninsured patients. Functions as a member of the Primary and Behavioral Health Care Integration Program team to assist patients in fully integrating primary and behavioral health care services. Duties include:

- Conducts patient screenings and assessments to identify physical and behavioral health needs.
- Conducts community and provider assessments to identify service trends, resources, and service gaps.
- Establishes and adheres to protocols for clinical data collection, reporting, and information sharing among providers.
- Implements an evidence-based model for integrated team care.
- Actively participates in multidisciplinary team and program leadership meetings; regularly accepting and completing assignments.
- Develop and maintain community partnerships to improve treatment outcomes.
- Co-directs the Primary and Behavioral Health Care Integration Program.
- As requested/required administers adult and child vaccinations through Department Immunization program.
- Maintains confidentiality.

Ability to:

- Complete all required integration model and public health training.
- Assess physical, emotional, social and environmental needs of clients.
- Provide education, support and referral resources in assisting clients with attaining their targeted goals.
- Consult and collaborate with other professionals involved in providing services to clients.
- Formulate nursing diagnosis based on nursing assessment and client goals.
- Evaluate client progress toward stated goals and outcomes.
- Plan patient visits in accordance with client goals and outcomes.
- Attend and participate in case conferences and team meetings.
- Participates in review and analysis of reports for achievements and areas for improvement.
- Documents appropriately and timely submits data and reports.
- Performs related duties as assigned or required.

Special Qualification:

- Current RN license (in good standing) & Current CPR required.
- Two years recent experience in maternal/child health, public health, home visiting or mental/behavioral nursing preferred.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills, basic computer skills.
- Valid Utah driver's license and insured automobile required.
- Must successfully pass a background check and pre-employment drug screening.
- Must be able to work a flexible schedule including some evenings and weekends (per agency requirements).
- Able to meet physical demands of conducting home visits including but not limited to bending, stooping, climbing stairs, lifting 50 lbs.
