### **Repair Assistance**

200% and below poverty level are allowed 100% of qualifying repair bill up to \$1,000 (maximum benefit).

201-250% of poverty level are allowed 75% of qualifying repair bill up to \$750 (maximum benefit).

251-300% of poverty level are allowed 50% of qualifying repair bill up to \$500 (maximum benefit).

Poverty levels will be adjusted each year according to federal guidelines.

### **Replacement Assistance**

| Poverty Level  | Assistance Amount for Tier 2 Bin 5 through Tier 2 Bin 3 | Assistance Amount for Tier 2 Bin 2 or cleaner |
