New emissions inspector training:

1 – New inspectors must take the online training course before attending class. This can be located through our website, www.brhd.org, or directly at cacheim.autosciencetech.org. The inspector must enter the course through the “I/M Inspector Login”. Do not log in under “Guest Login”; this option will not save any information entered.

2 – After the online training is complete, new inspectors must call our office and register for an upcoming in-house training course, no less than 24 hours before the class begins, at 435-792-6579. New inspectors will do practice inspections during this training.

3 – Fees are \$50.00 for new inspector training. As long as fees are paid, new or renewing inspectors will leave the in-house training with a username and access code, and may start emissions inspections the following day.

Current emissions inspector refresher training:

Current Certified Emissions Inspectors are required to complete a refresher training course every 2 years. This must be completed no more than 60 days prior to the date of expiration. Notices will be sent to inspectors due for training. If an inspector allows certification to expire beyond one year, they will be required to follow the new inspector training criteria for certification.

Inspectors in need of refresher training must call our office and register for an upcoming course no less than 24 hours before class begins. The fee for renewal is \$15.00, and a \$10.00 late charge for renewals past renewal deadline date.
