Reinstatement Process

A tobacco retailer that fails to renew a permit before the permit expires may apply to reinstate the permit by submitting to the local health department:

- An application for a tobacco retailer permit. Submit the application at https://brhd.org/forms/tobacco-retailer-permit/. (Note: Application must include a copy of the valid Utah State Tax Commission Cigarette/Tobacco Products License or Electronic Cigarette and Nicotine Products License for the location being applied for);
- The \$30 fee for the reinstatement of a permit; and
- A signed affidavit affirming that the tobacco retailer has not violated the prohibitions in Subsection <u>26-62-201(1)(b)</u>. (See Utah Code <u>26-62-203</u>; Administrative Rule <u>R384-324-3</u>)

Utah Code Annotated Subsection 26-62-201(1)(b) is as follows:

(b) A tobacco retailer without a valid permit may not:

(i) place a tobacco product, an electronic cigarette product, or a nicotine product in public view;

(ii) display any advertisement related to a tobacco product, an electronic cigarette product, or a nicotine product that promotes the sale, distribution, or use of those products; or

(iii) sell, offer for sale, or offer to exchange any form of consideration, tobacco, a tobacco product, an electronic cigarette product, or a nicotine product.

By signing this I am affirming that the tobacco retailer has not violated the prohibitions in Utah Code Subsection 26-62-201(1)(b) after the permit expired.
